



Antelope Point Marina Cart Policy

The purpose of this APM Policy is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all customers and APM personnel by setting forth a set of rules and guidelines to follow. Operation of a private cart is a privilege; APM reserves the right to stop any customer if said customer is driving unsafe at APM’s discretion; APM reserves the right to revoke this privilege as deemed necessary for the safety of our guests and staff. ***This policy and rules are subject to change by the concessionaire.***

1. All private carts must be pre-approved in writing by the APM/Administration prior to their entry. Any cart not approved by APM/Administration will be towed at the owner's expense.
2. All private carts must have an APM registration sticker Visible on carts front Driver side.
3. Only one cart is allowed to be associated with any customer Houseboat/Cruiser. No Houseboat/Cruiser shall have 2 carts.
4. Width of the cart must not exceed **60 inches** at its widest point.
5. All drivers of the cart must have a valid driver’s license and must be 16 and older.
6. Contact information and an insurance card of the cart must be on file with the Guest Services/Security Department.
7. Operation of cart under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol is not permitted and will result in privilege being revoked. **(NPS will be notified of any illegal affairs on APM property.)**
8. All private carts shall adhere to the signage posted throughout APM property (ex. cart path, parking lots, etc.)
9. Yield for carts coming up the cart path.
10. Move to the left side of the cart path to make room for passing carts.
11. No parking is allowed on the docks. All carts must be moved to the designated parking areas before departing the marina.
12. No parking at the marina store/bar/boat rental walkways.
13. No Parking at the Marina Village area for more than 1 hour.
14. No private carts will be allowed to park in the asphalt/gravel parking lot. All private carts shall park in the Overflow parking lot.
15. Customers will be held responsible for any damages/injuries to APM property and APM personnel. APM will not be held liable for any damages caused by a customer's cart.
16. No speeding. 8 MPH on the dock, 14 MPH on land. Drive safely and quietly.
17. All private carts shall reduce their speed when needing to compensate for inclines, pedestrians and any unsafe weather conditions.
18. All private carts shall approach sharp or blind corners with caution and reduced speed.
19. No reckless driving on the docks or anywhere on APM property.
20. No passengers in cargo areas. Passengers are only allowed in designated seating areas.
21. No Parking at turnaround areas located at the end of each docks.
22. No personal trailers can be attached to carts. All carts should be loaded to the appropriate loading capacities allowed per their manufacturer.

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21. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed at Owner’s expense.

22. All invitees of Owner, including family, guests, servants, help, labor, and all others are required to follow the same policies and procedures, included here, as Owner.

Disciplinary Actions

APM reserves the right to revoke this privilege even if the previous warnings have not been given. Disciplinary actions may include termination of cart privileges for at least one calendar year.
